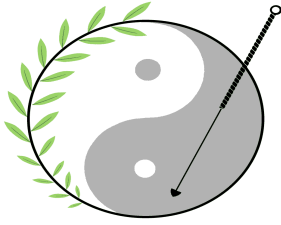

## Italian Greyhound

The name of the breed is a reference to the breed's popularity in Renaissance Italy. Mummified dogs very similar to the Italian Greyhound (or small Greyhounds) have been found in Egypt, and pictorials of small Greyhounds have been found in Pompeii, and they were probably the only accepted companion-dog there. Dogs similar to Italian Greyhounds are recorded as having been seen around Emperor Nero's court in Rome in the first century AD.

Although the small dogs are mainly companionship dogs they have in fact been used for hunting rats or mice, often in combination with hunting falcons.

The Italian Greyhound is the smallest of the family of gazehounds (dogs that hunt by sight). The breed is an old one and is believed to have originated more than 4,000 years ago in the countries now known as Greece and Turkey. This belief is based on the depiction of miniature greyhounds in the early decorative arts of these countries and on the archaeological discovery of small greyhound skeletons. By the Middle Ages, the breed had become distributed throughout Southern Europe and was later a favourite of the Italians of the sixteenth century, among whom

miniature dogs were in great demand. Sadly, though, 'designer' breeders tried, and failed, to make the breed even smaller by crossbreeding it with other breeds of dogs. This only led to mutations with deformed skulls, bulging eyes and dental problems. The original Italian Greyhound had almost disappeared when groups of breeders got together and managed to return the breed to normal.

From this period onward the history of the breed can be fairly well traced as it spread through Europe, arriving in England in the seventeenth century.

## THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT DOGS

1. Table scraps and other types of human food should never be given to your dog; they have very different nutrition needs from people. Some foods can make dogs seriously ill. For example, chocolate can be very toxic to a dog, even deadly. In order to ensure that you will have a healthy dog it is important to provide him with food formulated for dogs.
2. From the first day you have your new dog, you should ensure that you assume the role of the leader over your dog. Dogs are naturally pack animals and they will be frequent challenges to establish the leader of the pack. A dog will look at his new family as he would a pack dog. Your dog will try to become leader of this new pack leading to all sorts of problems including barking and lack of control. You need to prove that YOU are the leader of the pack.
3. When a dog rolls over it may be an indication that it wants you to scratch their stomach but in this vulnerable position (with the throat exposed) your dog is letting you know that he completely trusts you. It is also a sign of submission (you are the leader!) Make sure you take the time to show your affection by gently patting or stroking his stomach.
4. Grooming is not only a good way to ensure that your dog has a healthy coat, but also a great way to bond with your dog and to let him become familiar with your scent. Stroking him gently with a brush makes him feel loved and accepted as well as clean.
5. When first introducing a dog to a new home, it's important to walk him around the house and backyard to familiarize him with his new surroundings. It is also a good idea to show him his sleeping, eating areas and the door to outside.
6. Obedience training should start on day one. The dog must be taught what is acceptable behaviour and what is not. A poorly trained dog is not only a nuisance but also a danger to himself. Many pet owners make the mistake of allowing bad behaviour in puppies because they think that it is cute, and then later punishing the dog for the same acts. This is very confusing for a dog and can lead to worse behaviour.
7. During obedience training, your two best options are your voice and consistency. Your dog does not react to verbal commands "yes" and "no", but rather the tone of your voice. When you are scolding a dog, your tone of voice is usually harsh and it gets your dog's attention. But, when you are happy with him, your tone is soothing and relaxing. Each command should maintain a consistent tone.
8. Never leave small children alone with a dog or allow older kids to play roughly with them. Dogs have a natural predatory instinct, which cannot totally be controlled.
